




# Texas added 470,000 new residents in 2022, most among the 10 largest states







## Dallas-Fort Worth is the 4th largest metropolitan area

## Dallas Fort Worth continues to add more residents than any other metro in the U.S. in 2022






## Dallas Fort Worth region saw the largest net migration in the U.S. in 2022





DFW area added nearly 600k jobs and is more than 11% beyond pre-pandemic levels






## Percentage beyond peak pre-pandemic employment


