North Satellite Concourse

- Floor area: 20,000m²
- 10 bridge-served stands

Midfield Concourse

- 18 retail and 4 catering outlets

Parking spaces

- Car parks 1, 4, 5 and SkyCity car park provide about 3,000 parking spaces
- Coach station at T2 provides 36 pick-up bays for coaches

Multi-modal transportation from T1 or T2

Connection with local destinations:

- Airport Express Line arrives at Central downtown in 24 minutes, AsiaWorld-Expo in 2 minutes
- Franchised bus companies operate about 49 routes

Connection with the Pearl River Delta:

- Coaches make 550 daily trips between HKIA and more than 110 Mainland cities/towns
- Ferries at SkyPier arrive at 9 ports in the PRD and Macau in 30-90 minutes
- SkyLimo (Mainland Limousines) operates a fleet of 295 vehicles serving HKIA and the PRD cities every day
